	The additional levies shall be on Class I property, 16.75 cents; on Class II property, 33.50 cents; on Class III property, 67.00 cents; and on Class IV property, 67.00 cents.
	Whenever, in any of said five (5) fiscal years any annual appraisal or general valuation of property produces property assessments that would cause an increase in the total property tax revenues that would be realized by the imposition of the foregoing levy rates, and which increase in property tax revenues would exceed the projected needed revenue for that year, The Board of Education of the County of Monongalia reserves unto itself as the levying body the right and authority to reduce such additional levy rates in such fiscal year in accordance with the provisions of Section 6g, Article 8, Chapter 11of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended. Nothing herein shall affect any special levy or levies for the retirement of bonded indebtedness.
	Additional assessments due to new construction or improvements to existing real property, including beginning recovery of natural resources, and newly acquired personal property shall not be included in determining whether to reduce excess levy rates for any such fiscal year.
