Monongalia County Urban Mass Transportation Authority Levy

Election to authorize a levy for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017, July 1, 2018, July 1, 2019, and July 1, 2020 for the purpose of contributing funds from such levy to the Monongalia County Urban Mass Transportation Authority (Mountain Line) for the acquisition of equipment and other capital improvements, and payment of a portion of its general operating, maintenance and other expenses in the amount of \$1,803,711 annually and \$9,018,555 during the term of the levy. The need for such funding has been determined by the County Commission according to the Order of the County Commission of Monongalia County, West Virginia, entered on the 24th day of February, 2016.

The additional levy in cents per one hundred dollars assessed valuation of property for each of the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017, July 1, 2018, July 1, 2019, and July 1, 2020 shall be:

Class I Property -	1.10 cents
Class II Property -	2.20 cents
Class III Property -	4.40 cents
Class IV Property -	4.40 cents

Parks, Trails, and Recreation Levy

Election to authorize a levy for fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017, July 1, 2018, July 1, 2019, and July 1, 2020 for the purpose of providing funding and maintenance of the Parks, Trails, and Recreation programs in the amount of \$951,047 annually and \$4,755,235 during the term of the levy according to the Order of the Monongalia County Commission entered on the 24th day of February, 2016.

The funding items include: Operation, Expenses, and other Capital Improvements for Camp Muffy Park, Chestnut Ridge Park, Mason-Dixon Historical Park, Mon River and Deckers Creek Rail-Trails, Westover Park Baseball Facilities, Cheat Lake and Laurel Point soccer fields and the Morgantown Ice Arena.

The additional levy in cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on each class of property within Monongalia County shall be as follows:

Class I Property	.58 cents
Class II Property	1.16 cents
Class III Property	2.32 cents
Class IV Property	2.32 cents

Fire Protection Levy

Election to authorize a levy for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017, July 1, 2018, July 1, 2019 and July 1, 2020 for the Monongalia County Volunteer Fire Departments, the Monongalia Hazardous Incident Response Team, the Monongalia County Brush Fire Team and the Monongalia County Volunteer Fire Companies Association Inc. in the amount of \$688,689 annually and \$3,443,445 during the term of the levy according to the Order of the County Commission entered on the 24th day of February, 2016.

The additional rate of levy in cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on each class of property shall be:

Class I Property	.42 cents
Class II Property	.84 cents
Class III Property	1.68 cents
Class IV Property	1.68 cents

In the event the separate and aggregate assessed value of each class of taxable property within the County increases during the term of the special excess levy, the levy rate shall be reduced so that the projected tax collection will not exceed \$688,689 in any fiscal year.

Morgantown Public Library System Levy

Election to authorize a levy for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017, July 1, 2018, July 1, 2019, and July 1, 2020 for the Morgantown Public Library System in the amount of \$442,730 annually and \$2,213,650 during the term of the levy; according to the Order of the County Commission entered on the 24th day of February, 2016.

The additional rate of levy in cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on each class of property shall be:

Class I Property	0.27 cents
Class II Property	0.54 cents
Class III Property	1.08 cents
Class IV Property	1.08 cents

In the event the separate and aggregate assessed value of each class of taxable property within the County increases during the term of the special excess levy, any surplus funds received may be utilized for the same purposes during the fiscal year so received.

Youth Baseball/Softball and Botanic Garden Levy

Election to authorize a levy for fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017, July 1, 2018, July 1, 2019, and July 1, 2020 for the purpose of providing funding and maintenance of eight (8) BOPARC youth baseball and youth softball fields, and related bleachers, concession stands, and pavilions, and the West Virginia Botanic Garden (excluding staff salaries) in Monongalia County, West Virginia, in the amount of \$100,038 annually and \$500,190 during the term of the levy according to the Order of the Monongalia County Commission entered on the 29th day of February, 2016.

Those funding items include: Operation, Expenses, and other Capital Improvements for BOPARC youth baseball and youth softball fields at White Park, Krepps Park, Marilla Park, Jack Roberts Park, and Valley View and for the West Virginia Botanic Garden.

The additional levy in cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on each class of property within Monongalia County shall be as follows:

Class I Property	.06 cents
Class II Property	.12 cents
Class III Property	.24 cents
Class IV Property	.24 cents

Fairs Levy

Election to authorize a levy for fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017, July 1, 2018, July 1, 2019, and July 1, 2020 for the purpose of providing funding and maintenance of three fairs in Monongalia County, West Virginia, in the amount of \$85,747 annually and \$428,735 during the term of the levy according to the Order of the Monongalia County Commission entered on the 29th day of February, 2016.

Those funding items include: Operation, Expenses, and other Capital Improvements for Clay District Fair Association, Monongalia County Fair Association, Inc., and Battelle District Fair Association.

The additional levy in cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on each class of property within Monongalia County shall be as follows:

Class I Property	.05 cents
Class II Property	.10 cents
Class III Property	.20 cents
Class IV Property	.20 cents
