MONONGALIA COUNTY URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY LEVY

Election to authorize a levy for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 for the purpose of contributing funds from such levy to the Monongalia County Urban Mass Transportation Authority (Mountain Line) for the acquisition of equipment and other capital improvements, and payment of a portion of its general operating, maintenance and other expenses in the amount of \$1,994,843 annually and \$7,979,372 during the term of the Levy. The need for such funding has been determined by the County Commission according to the Order of the County Commission of Monongalia County, West Virginia, entered on the 19th day of February, 2020.

The additional levy for each one hundred dollars assessed valuation of property for each of the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2021, July 1, 2022, July 1, 2023 and July 1, 2024 shall be:

- Class I property - 1.10 cents
- Class II property - 2.20 cents
- Class III property - 4.40 cents
- Class IV property - 4.40 cents

MORGANTOWN PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM LEVY

A special election to authorize additional levies for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2021, July 1, 2022, July 1, 2023, and July 1, 2024, for the Morgantown Public Library System in the amount of **\$489,644 annually** and **\$1,958,576 during the term of the levy**; according to the Order of the County Commission entered on the 19th day of February, 2020.

That the additional rate of levy in cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on each class of property shall be:

- Class I 0.27 cents
- Class II 0.54 cents
- Class III 1.08 cents
- Class IV 1.08 cents

In the event the separate and aggregate assessed value of each class of taxable property within the County increases during the term of the special excess levy, any surplus funds received may be utilized for the same purposes during the fiscal year so received.

An election to authorize additional levies for the fiscal years beginning **July 1, 2021, July 1, 2022, July 1, 2023 and July 1, 2024** for the purpose of providing for the adequate level of funding for each of the said organizations in the following amounts adopted by the Monongalia County Commission on February 19, 2020.

PARKS, TRAILS, AND RECREATION LEVY

A Levy for fiscal years beginning **July 1, 2021, July 1, 2022, and July 1, 2023, and July 1, 2024** for the purpose of providing funding and maintenance of the Parks, Trails, and Recreation programs in the amount of \$1,051,828 annually and \$4,207,312 during the term of the levy according to the Order of the Monongalia County Commission entered on the 19th day of February, 2020.

Those funding items include: Operation, Expenses, and other Capital Improvements for **Camp Muffly Park, Chestnut Ridge Park, Mason-Dixon Historical Park, Mon River and Deckers Creek Rail-Trails, WV Botanic Garden, Westover Park Baseball Facilities, Cheat Lake and Laurel Point soccer fields and the Morgantown Ice Arena.**

The Additional Levy in cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on each class of property for each of the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2021, July 2022, July, 2023, and July 2024 within Monongalia County shall be as follows:

- Class I properties .58 cents
- Class II properties 1.16 cents
- Class III properties 2.32 cents
- Class IV properties 2.32 cents
