The County Commission, meeting as a Board of Canvassers for the Special Election held on Saturday, September 9, 1989, convened at 10:30 o'clock A.M. on Friday, September 15, 1989.

Circuit Clerk, Jean Friend, directly delivered to the Board of Canvassers an envelope containing absentee challenged ballots; and it was unanimously decided by the Board of Canvassers, after reviewing the same, that the following nine (9) absentee challenged ballots would be counted, after the County Clerk had ascertained that they were registered voters and were properly registered in the right precincts:

- One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 2.
- One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 3.
- One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 5.
- Two (2) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 18.
- One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 19.
- One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 23.
- One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 62.
- One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 90.

It was unanimously decided by the Board of Canvassers not to count one unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 72, inasmuch as the voter had died prior to election day and had not executed the absentee voter's ballot #2 envelope.

The Board of Canvassers recessed at 11:00 o'clock A.M. to reconvene at 10:30 o'clock A.M. on Monday, September 18, 1989, after the County Commission meeting.

The Board of Canvassers reconvened at 10:30 o'clock A.M., on Monday, September 18, 1989, to continue the canvassing for the Saturday, September 9, 1989, Special Election.

The Board of Canvassers began to compare the Tally Sheets and the Certificates of Result made by the precinct officials to determine if they are genuine and certified in form and manner substantially according to the statute. No discrepancies were found.

The Board of Canvassers then checked the challenged ballots to determine the number of challenged ballots in each precinct. It was directed that the County Clerk's office perform a synopsis on the challenged ballots cast to ascertain which are registered, eligible voters and which are properly registered in the right precincts; and further to determine why said ballots were challenged. There were One Hundred and Sixty One (161) challenged ballots.

Thereafter the Board of Canvassers compared the Poll Tickets with the Ballots and Challenged Ballots.

The Board of Canvassers reconvened at 1:15 o'clock A.M. on Wednesday, September 20, 1989, to review the Challenged Ballots of the Saturday, September 9, 1989, Special Election, and to determine which Challenged Ballots cast would be allowed or disallowed. The Board of Canvassers unanimously agreed to allow the ninety (97) pollworkers' challenged ballots inasmuch as the pollworkers had to vote in the polling places where they worked, which were outside of their correct precincts; and they also agreed to allow the one (1) challenged ballot of the voter registration clerk who voted in Precinct 10, the Courthouse, which was outside of her precinct because she had to work during the election and could not make it to her precinct to vote. The Board of Canvassers unanimously agreed to disallow fifteen (15) challenged ballots for persons voting in incorrect precincts and directed the County Clerk to inform said individuals by letter of their correct precincts to vote. The Board of Canvassers unanimously agreed to disallow four (4) challenged ballots because the individuals were cancelled for failure to vote in past elections and therefore not registered and to disallow ten (10) challenged ballots because the individuals were not registered at all. The Board of Directors again directed the County Clerk to inform said individuals that they are not registered because of forfeiture of registration due to failure to vote in past elections or because of just not being registered. The Board of Canvassers unanimously agreed to allow the fourteen (14) challenged ballots of voters who had gone to Precinct 54, Jakes Run School, instead of their correct Precinct 56, Hagan's Christian Church, because of the long distance that they had to travel. County Clerk Thelma J. Gibson stated that previously these people had voted at the McCurdysville Community Center; but because of its deteriorated condition, the polling place had been changed to the Hagan's Christian Church, which apparently was a long distance for said voters to travel. The Board of Canvassers decided that something would have to be done in the near future about the Precinct 56 polling place. The Board of Canvassers unanimously decided to allow said fourteen (14) challenged ballots inasmuch as they do not cross over Senatorial lines and will not have an affect on the outcome of the election. The Board of Canvassers unanimously decided to allow twelve (12) challenged ballots of individuals who had moved out of their precincts but had failed to change their address. The County Clerk was directed to inform said individuals to come in and change their addresses. The Board of Canvassers unanimously decided to allow six (6) challenged ballots due to clerical mistakes by the pollworkers and to allow two (2) challenged ballots of voters who are located Sundale Rest Home, being Precinct 22, but have kept their home addresses as their residence and therefore voted in the precincts of their residence instead of Precinct 22, which was correct.

The Board determined that of the 161 Challenged Ballots cast to allow 132 and to disallow 29. The Board of Canvassers at their Friday, September 15, 1989, meeting had previously decided to allow nine (9) absentee challenged ballots.

The Board of Canvassers began opening the Challenged Ballots and Absentee Ballots, which were placed face down; and immediately The Board of Canvassers proceeded to count said ballots and tally such votes for each amendment.

The Board of Canvassers completed the counting and tabulating of the Challenged Ballots and Absentee Ballots at 1:45 o'clock P.M.; and the Board of Canvassers publicly declared the results of the Saturday, September 9, 1989, Special Election, and the canvass complete. The Board of Canvassers ordered the County Clerk's office to add such tally of challenged votes to each amendment on the abstracts.

The Board of Canvassers recessed at 1:50 o'clock P.M. to reconvene on Friday, September 22, 1989, at 2:00 o'clock P.M. to certify said results of the September 9, 1989, Special Election.

AMENDMENT NO. 3 - BETTER GOVERNMENT


AGAINST THE AMENDMENT - SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY (7,150)

County Clerk, Thelma J. Gibson, presented to the Board of Canvassers an envelope containing five (5) absentee challenged ballots that had been handed to Ward D. Stone, Jr., President of the School Board, by Circuit Clerk, Jean Friend; and it was unanimously decided by the Board of Canvassers, after reviewing the same, that the following (2) absentee challenged ballots would be counted and added to the challenged ballots, after the County Clerk had ascertained that they were registered voters and were properly registered in the right precincts:

One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 71
One (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 27

It was unanimously decided by the Board of Canvassers not to count one (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 27 and one (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 3, inasmuch as they were postmarked November 18, 1989, the day of the election and were not received until November 22, 1989; and also not to count one (1) unopened absentee challenged ballot for Precinct 37 inasmuch as there was no signature of the voter on the outside of the envelope and there was no statement of the physician.

BOARD OF CANVASSERS
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 1989, CONTINUED

County Clerk Thelma J. Gibson also presented an envelope containing three (3) absentee ballots from Precinct 2 that had been inadvertently overlooked by the Pollworkers and then hand delivered to the County Clerk's office. It was the unanimous decision of the Board of Canvassers that the three (3) absentee ballots would be counted and added to the challenged ballots if properly registered and in the right precinct.

At the request of Jack Dulaney, Superintendent of Schools, four (4) precincts were randomly selected for the purpose of manually counting the ballots to determine if the results are identical to the results obtained by the pollworkers. The Board of Canvassers chose Precinct Nos. 7, 13, 51, and 77.

Precinct No. 51 had two (2) unopened absentee ballots that should have been delivered to Precinct 49 sealed with the voted ballots; and it was decided that they should also be counted and added to the challenged ballots if properly registered and in the right precinct.

The following discrepancy was noted:

Precinct No. 77 - There should have been 208 yes votes instead of 213 yes votes as indicated on the Tally Sheet and the Certificate of Results.

The Board of Canvassers then proceeded to compare the total votes shown on the remaining Tally Sheets with the votes recorded on the Certificates of Results; and no further discrepancies were noted.

The Board proceeded to open each sealed package of ballots so laid before them, and without unfolding them, count the number in each package and compare the same with the number of poll tickets signed. The ballots were then sealed up carefully in a new envelope and signed by each member of the Board. All ballots and poll tickets were checked.

One (1) unopened and uncounted absentee ballot was found with the ballots in Precinct No. 3, and it was decided that the same should be counted and added to the challenged ballots if properly registered and in the right precinct.

The Board then began to open the large envelopes containing the challenged ballot envelopes to determine the exact number of challenged ballots cast. It was determined that there was a total of one hundred and seventy two (172) regular challenged ballots, two (2) absentee challenged ballots and six (6) regular absentee ballots.

It was directed that the County Clerk's office perform a synopsis on the challenged ballots cast to ascertain which are registered, eligible voters and which are properly registered in the right precincts; and further to determine why said ballots were challenged.

Following are the total votes cast at each precinct as determined by the Board of Canvassers:




