Thereafter, the Canvassing Board proceeded to remove the Challenged Ballots from their respective envelopes, and to place them face down to preserve their secrecy. Tallying of the Challenged Ballots was completed at 4:55 o'clock P.M. with results of the Challenged Ballots as follows: One Hundred and Six (106) "Yes" and Fifty Five (55) "No". Said Ballots were then ordered such tally to be added to the abstracts.

The Board of Canvassersdirected that the County Clerk's office perform a synopsis on the Challenged Ballots cast to ascertain which are registered, eligible voters and which were properly registered in the right precincts; and further to determine why said Ballots were challenged.
