The County Commission, meeting as a Board of Canvassers for the Special Election held on Saturday, September 27, 1997, convened at 3:00 o'clock P.M. on Thursday, October 2, 1997.

Circuit Clerk Deputy, Carolyn Harsh, directly delivered to the Board of Canvassers an envelope containing six (6) absentee challenged ballots; and it was unanimously decided by the Board of Canvassers that the ballots would be counted, after the County Clerk had ascertained that they were registered voters and were properly registered in the correct precincts.

The Board of Canvassers began to compare the Tally Sheets, Poll Books and the Certificate of Results made by the precinct officials to determine if they are genuine and certified in form and manner substantially according to the statute. No discrepancies were found.

The Board of Canvassers then checked the challenged ballots to determine the number of challenged ballots in each precinct.

The ballots were then sealed into envelopes identified by precinct number with the Commissioners signatures across the seal of said envelopes. Said envelopes were then placed in the vault.

A motion was duly made Commissioner Wiley, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to recess the Board of Canvassers at 5:05 o'clock P.M. to reconvene at 10:00 A.M. on Friday, October 3, 1997.

The summary of reasons for the twenty (20) challenged ballots

precinct; five (5) voters were not registered.

Thereafter, the Canvassing Board proceeded to remove the
Challenged Ballots from their respective envelopes, and to place
them face down to preserve their secrecy. Tallying of the
Challenged Ballots was completed at 4:55 o'clock P.M. with
results of the Challenged Ballots as follows: One Hundred and Six
(106) "Yes" and Fifty Five (55) "No". Said Ballots were then
ordered such tally to be added to the abstracts.

The Board of Canvassers directed that the County Clerk's office
perform a synopsis on the Challenged Ballots cast to ascertain
which are registered, eligible voters and which were properly
registered in the right precincts; and further to determine why
said Ballots were challenged.




