PRECINCT NO. 30


SABRATON JR. HIGH SCHOOL

Thence with Precinct No. 33 and No. 35 and said corporation line to the place of beginning.

PRECINCT NO. 38

BROOKHAVEN SCHOOL

BEGINNING at a point in West Virginia Route 67/4 (commonly known as the Sub-Station Road), and the Union District line. Thence with a straight line in a southwesterly direction to Reeds Run. Thence with Reeds Run in a southwesterly direction to its intersection with West Virginia Route 67 or the Vandervort School Road. Thence with a straight line to West Virginia Route 7/22 or the Brookhaven Road which point is approximately 450 feet from its intersection with the Dellslow-Tyrone Road. Thence with a straight line in a southwesterly direction to the bridge on Deckers Creek near the Richard Elementary School. Thence in a westerly direction along the north side of Deckers Creek to its intersection with West Virginia Route 7. Thence in a westerly direction along the east side of West Virginia Route 7 to the Morgantown Corporation line, corner to Precinct No. 30. Thence along said corporation line and Precinct No. 30 in a northerly direction to a point in the center of Dug Hill Road and Precinct No. 30 and the Morgantown Corporation Line, corner to Precinct No. 32; thence with Precinct No. 32 and Dug Hill Road easterly to the cross-roads near Pleasant Hill Church; thence along Route 67 to the Union and Morgan District lines, corner to Precinct No. 32; thence with the Union District line to the place of beginning.

Precinct No. 11--There were improperly sealed ballots found, these were disallowed by the Board.

In regards to the Ballot that Jean Friend, Circuit Clerk, delivered to the Board, Mr. Kun stated that we have no way of knowing when this ballot came in to her, maybe it was after the election. The Board disallowed this Ballot.

Mr. Jackson wanted it noted that the Board is accepting the Prosecuting Attorney's opinion that he had received from the Secretary of State as to not allowing those that had moved out of Precinct and voting out of precinct where registered.

There are (131) One hundred thirty-one Challenged Ballots disallowed. (1) One Republican Ballot and (1) one Democrat Ballot in Precinct No. 90 in same envelope. These were disallowed. Dog Race and Board of Education Ballots were counted.

The Challenged votes were counted on the Ballots that were allowed. The Tally Sheets were examined by the Commissioners and found to all be in order.




The Board of Canvassers reconvened at 12:05 p.m. on Friday, October 13, 1978. 

The County Commission sitting as a Board of Canvassers convened on Friday, November 10, 1978 at 1:10 p.m. in the back part of the County Clerk's Record Room and began to examine the ballots, poll books, registration cards, tally sheets and certificates which were placed before them to determine that they are genuine and certified in form and manner substantially according to law. The Board proceeded to check the Certificate of Results and Tally sheets stating that in three precincts they counted both Senatorial races, and they should have counted only one. In Precinct (7) seven-14th Senatorial District William Moreland and Richard D. Lindsay votes were allowed and Gerald W. (Jerry) Ash and C. N. (Bud) Harman votes were disallowed. Precinct (52) fifty-two-14th Senatorial District, William Moreland and Richard D. Lindsay votes were allowed and Gerald W. (Jerry) Ash and C. N. (Bud) Harman votes were disallowed. Precinct (62) sixty-two-15th Senatorial District, Gerald W. (Jerry) Ash and C. N. (Bud) Harman votes were counted and William Moreland and Richard D. Lindsay votes were disallowed.

Richard E. Davies asked if anyone had any objection of his canvassing the votes. Both of the Commission members stated-no objection. In Precinct (33) Thirty-three, Clyde W. Hagedorn received 110 votes on the Tally Sheet but received 115 votes on the Certificate of Results. The Commission ruled it should have been 110 votes. This made Mr. Hagedorn losing (5) five votes. In Precinct (80) in the House of Delegate race Ernie B. McCue lost (3) three votes. The Certificate of Results showed (114) votes and the Tally Sheet showed (111) votes. In Precinct (83) in the House of Delegate race Larry Edward Schifano received (102) votes--this was allowed by the Commission. Clyde H. Richey, also a candidate for the House of Delegates, in Precinct (83) lost (1) vote. Total votes received (101). The Commission stated that Clyde W. Hagedorn could look at the Certificate of Results if he wanted. The Commission asked Mr. Jackson, County Clerk to check the challenged ballots as to proper registration. The Commission opened the challenged ballots and they are as follows: Also the comparison of Poll Tickets and Ballots Cast, are as follows:


